

U.S. Consulate Moves To New Location In Tijuana

The Consulate General of the United States in Tijuana has moved to a new location. The new Consulate General is located on Paseo de las Culturas s/n en Mesa de Otay, Delegación Centenario in Tijuana. Construction for the new building was initiated in 2008 and opened to the public this July 18.



The new building was designed by Integrus Architecture of Spokane, Washington and is LEED certified. The new Consulate General compound includes a main building, workshops, and gardens that occupy more than 10 acres. The buildings include improved space for assisting American citizens and visa applicants, as well as space for cultural and educational events. The new building integrates all offices of the government of the United States with a presence in Tijuana into one building for better coordination.

Public services ceased as of July 8th in the former facilities located on calle Tapachula #96 in colonia Hipódromo. The Consular annex located on calle Diego Rivera #2 Zona Rio has also closed. Public services at the new building began on July 18th. The telephone numbers to obtain information and make visa appointments remain the same (664-140-6041). Visa applicants are asked to follow the instructions given to them at the Applicants' Service Center (ASC), which continues normal operations.
